

Application Guidelines for funding to attend the 24th Commonwealth Law Conference 2025 Malta (CLC25)

The Commonwealth Lawyers Association is pleased to offer 3 grants of up to a maximum of £2,000 GBP each to assist lawyers (under 40 or within 7 years of call) to attend the Commonwealth Law Conference in Malta in 2025.

Applications will only be accepted from lawyers from, or practising in, a Commonwealth jurisdiction. Students of law are not eligible for the funding, which is for qualified lawyers only.

- 1. All applications for funding should be received by the Commonwealth Lawyers Association (CLA) by Monday 6th January 2025
- 2. The following information should be provided as part of your application:
 - A) A short explanation (500 words max) of your current circumstance in relation to your career in the law and the reasons why you think you should be considered for a support grant.
 - B) The conference programme and an explanation of those parts of the programme which are most relevant and important to you.
 - C) The registration rate for which you are eligible.
 - D) Details and costs of the accommodation at which you are intending to stay.
 - E) Details of the range of available travel costs applicable.
 - F) Full details of all funding commitments that you have already received and other funding you are seeking.
 - G) A reference from a senior member of the legal profession that speaks to character and work ethic including their email address.
- 3. Successful applicants are required to write and send in an article of their experience in participating at the conference within 2 months of attendance which will be posted in the CLA newsletter.
- 4. These guidelines are subject to change by the CLA.
